Schools may apply for Erasmus+: Key Action 1 funding for their teachers to attend courses in the UK.

Teachers with Erasmus+ funding and those paying with their own or other funds are welcome to apply for ISP courses.

The next annual Erasmus+ KA1 deadline will be 2 February 2016 for courses starting 01 June 2016 – 31 December 2017. Schools should first register on-line to obtain a Personal Identification Code (PIC) number for the school. Applications for funding should then be made on-line to applicants' National Agency for Erasmus+.
